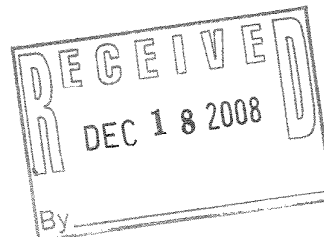




MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 5, 2008 ATHLETIC DIRECTORS' MEETING
