The nominations must have the support of a school administrator. When considering nominees, please weigh longevity, contributions, and distinguished service as important factors.

The successful candidate could be a coach, administrator, trainer, parent, community volunteer, etc.

- A woman who has provided long-term service (a minimum of 10 years) to your school and/or community in support of girls sports and athletics.
- A woman who has made a significant impact on the lives of young girls and women in your school/ community.
- A woman who has consistently served as a positive role model for girls and women.
