

2008 GIRLS LACROSSE MIAA RULE MODIFICATIONS

1 - The 2008 rules (changed for 2007) state that numbers on the back must be eight inches tall; numbers on the front must be six inches tall and must be centered at chest level. The Girls Lacrosse Committee voted unanimously to allow the MIAA Liaison, Dick Baker, to waive this rule if any schools were in non-compliance due to using past uniforms. 2008 BOYS LACROSSE MIAA RULE MODIFICATIONS

1. The 2008 NFHS Rule 1-9 states that:
 - g. Jerseys shall be of a single, solid color with the following trim specifications permitted:
 1. Collar, cuffs and waistband may be of contrasting colors, but not more than 2 inches wide.
 2. Side inserts (armpit to waistband) may be of contrasting color(s), but no more than 3 inches wide.
 3. Numbers shall be centered vertically and horizontally and at least 8 inches tall on the front and at least 12 inches tall on the back.
 4. Numbers may contain contrasting color trim(s) not to exceed 2 inches (the number shall contrast with the body of the jersey).
 5. The jersey shall completely cover the shoulder pads.
 - h. Uniform shorts: All players on the same team shall wear uniform shorts of the same dominate color.

The MIAA Boys Lacrosse Committee voted unanimously to allow MIAA Liaison, Dick Baker, to waive this rule if any schools were in non-compliance due to using past uniforms. Any schools wishing to request a waiver should send email request to nhuntley@miaa.net
