### 2017-2018 MIAA Gymnastics Tournament Format

#### A. Boys Championship Information

#### Qualifying Information (Team and Individual meets are held simultaneously.)

a. Team Championship

The team meet will involve the eight teams with the highest dual meet average. League Champions automatically qualify. Seeding will be determined by averaging scores from a team's five (5) best meets.

b. Individual Championship

Qualifying Scores for Boys' Individuals:

A gymnast must average the following scores in three dual meets or he must finish in the top three places in his league meet with a qualifying score.

### 2. Boys Eligibility Commitment Form Information

- a. Please e-mail the entries to Tournament Director Michael Denise with your gymnasts in the listed events according to ability with your best gymnast last. The entered gymnasts must meet all MIAA eligibility requirements.
- b. Each team may enter six gymnasts in each event.
- c. Only one gymnast may enter all six events and he will be designated the All-Around. Two other gymnasts may compete in more than three events (unlimited).
- In order to be considered for the all-around championship, a gymnast must compete in all six events.
- **Medical Coverage** A licensed athletic trainer, physician, physician's assistant, certified EMT, or nurse practitioner will be available at the State Meet.

#### B. Girls Gymnastic Championships Information

#### 1. Qualifying Information

- a. The Sectional team meets will include twelve (12) teams. Teams will be seeded on the basis of the average of their top four (4) scores throughout the year. Please note the following when submitting scores:
  - Dual meet scores may be submitted and counted once.
  - Tri-meet scores may be submitted and counted once.
  - League championship meet scores may be submitted and counted once.
  - League championship meet scores may only be submitted if a traditional "team score" was received (i.e. No more than two all-around competitors are allowed. All other gymnasts may enter no more than three events).
  - Individual scores may not be added to calculate a "team score" for league championship meets that do not provide a traditional "team score" as mentioned above.
  - Scores that were earned on one specific date against multiple opponents may not be submitted multiple times.
- b. League champions / runners-up will not automatically qualify for the tournament. At the sectional tournament the top four (4) teams from the North Sectional and South Sectional will advance to the state tournament.
- c. Qualifying information and line-up must be submitted to the Tournament Director by **Thursday**, **February 15, 2018** at 12:00 PM or sooner.

- d. A Seeding Meeting with the Liaison, Tournament Director and league representatives will take place on *Thursday, February 15, 2018* at 1:00 PM at the MIAA Office. Following the meeting the 12 qualifying teams from the North Section and 12 qualifying teams from the South Section will be posted on the MIAA website. *Phone calls will not be made.*
- e. No competitor or team will be allowed to compete without wearing the team uniform that has the school's name and/or insignia and/or colors.

#### 2. Warm Up

Each team will be allotted a 10 minute warm up for each event. In addition, each team will be allowed a 1 minute touch warm up prior to each competitive event. (When meets are conducted in a capital cup format, the allotted warm up time will not be 10 minutes.)

#### 3. Sectional Team Meet

- a. Please enter your gymnast(s) in the listed events according to competitive order. The entered gymnasts must meet all MIAA eligibility requirements.
  - Only student-athletes who are listed on the team roster will be admitted free of charge.
- b. Each team may enter six gymnasts in each event, not more than two of whom may be all-around performers. A team may compete 0, 1, or 2 all-arounds which must be designated on the entry form, as per the MIAA Handbook.
- c. The alternate will be allowed to compete only if there is an injury to one of your regular gymnasts.

#### 4. Medical Coverage

A licensed athletic trainer, physician, physician's assistant, certified EMT, or nurse practitioner will be available at the Sectional Meets and the State Meet.

#### 5. Breakfast of Champions

The annual <u>Gymnastics Breakfast of Champions</u> event for the Principal, Athletic Director, Coach and Captains of the 8 teams who advance to the State Meet as well as representatives from the Boys State Championship Team will take place at the **MIAA Office** on **Monday, February 26**<sup>th</sup> at **9:00 AM**.
