1. This is an 18-hole tournament. Players must be members of an MIAA member high school Golf Team.
2. Please do not enter this tournament unless you have played at least ten rounds of EIGHTEEN HOLES last year and scored below 100. Scores on Par 3 Golf Courses not allowed.
3. Only three (3) girls from each school will be allowed to enter the tournament. Their high school coach must accompany players or an official designee appointed by the principal (on school letterhead), and so noted on the tournament entry form. High Schools that register a golf team (Fall or Spring) are eligible to send students.
4. All contestants and coaches must be properly dressed. No dungarees, tank tops, etc. Players and coaches are expected to wear team shirts and presentable slacks or bermuda length shorts.
5. **Medical** - It is the responsibility of each participating school to provide for the first aid/medical needs of their student athletes.
