2025 MIAA DIVISION 3 WEST SECTIONAL WRESTLING TOURNAMENT UPDATED 2/12/25 due to Expected Storm

SEEDING MEETING THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 13th 6:00 PM (VIRTUAL)

- Coaches and Athletic Directors have received the link to the virtual meeting.
- Limit of two coaches per team at the seeding meeting. Coaches will receive their name badge and lanyard for use for the remainder of the MIAA Tournament on Saturday morning instead of at the seeding meeting.
- Per MIAA Tournament Format, the seeding committee will seed no more than nine (9) wrestlers per weight class. All other wrestlers will have their position drawn by lottery and placed in the first open bracket.
- All results should have been pre-entered into the FloArena website. Tournament entries will be due PRIOR to the seeding meeting. No late entries will be accepted. Coaches should have paper copies of weigh-in sheets (in case of a discrepancy in a FLO report) and their dual meet record forms available at the meeting. They will be submitted to the Coaches Rep during Team Check In on Saturday.

EVENT SCHEDULE (UPDATED DUE TO WEATHER PREDICTIONS) SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 15th

7:30AM Team Check In

- ✓ If at all possible, please have all members of the team travel together so they can enter the building together. This includes wrestlers, managers and all (3) coaches.
- ✓ All coaches must check in upon entry. Those who were not present at the seeding meeting will receive their MIAA Tournament name badge. Additional coaches will need a tournament pass or ticket.
- ✓ Teams will be asked to drop off their bags, food items and any coolers at their designated table in the School Cafeteria before proceeding to the gymnasium for weigh-in. <u>Please DO NOT bring a crock pot</u> <u>on site, it will be removed</u>. Wrestlers will have access to a microwave if they need to warm food brought from home.

7:50AM Weigh-Ins & Skin Checks.

- ✓ Skin checks will occur with the Head Referee and Head Trainer before any wrestler is permitted to weigh in. Any wrestler with a visible skin condition MUST present the MIAA Medical Release Form signed by a physician.
- ✓ Weigh Ins will occur on the mats so the results can be entered directly into the Meet Management program. They will be conducted by the sectional representative and the coach of the host school.
- ✓ Weigh Ins will be conducted "shoulder-to-shoulder" by weight class beginning with the 106lb class.
- ✓ All wrestlers must weigh in wearing a legal uniform.

8:30AM Doors Open to the Public

- ✓ Please clearly communicate this to the families of the wrestlers in your program. We would like to avoid having spectators standing outside in the cold for an hour prior to the sectional event.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

PARKING (TEAMS & SPECTATORS)

- Teams can be dropped off at the Main Entrance or the Cafeteria Entrance (no earlier than 7:30AM).
- Buses remaining on campus should park in the spaces at the end of the Bus Loop. If/When that area is full, please park in the back of the parking lot. Team Vans can park in the bus loop, or in a parking space in the Main Lot.
- <u>Spectators should park in the Main Parking Lot and enter through the Main Entrance</u>. Please only park in a marked parking space and only park in an accessible space if you have the appropriate accessibility tag.

LOCKER ROOMS/BATHROOMS

- Locker Rooms should be used by Wrestlers (and coaches) ONLY.
- Wrestlers may use the boys' locker room, the girls' locker room or the gender-neutral bathroom. The hallway with the locker rooms should be used by teams and meet personnel only. Spectators are not allowed in that area.
- There will be bathrooms clearly marked for public/spectator use.
- Please note the hallway where the locker rooms are located is for athletes, coaches and officials

TICKETING

- All tickets must be purchased through GoFan and redeemed on site.
- There will be NO CASH option at the door.

- PLEASE communicate this to all families and possible spectators.
- Official MIAA tournament passes will be accepted with a sign in process.
- All coaches not arriving with the team must have a ticket or an MIAA Tournament pass.

GYM LOGISTICS, FORMAT, SEATING & AWARDS

- Please keep ALL walkways clear of people and bags in case of an emergency.
- All wrestlers/spectators should watch matches from the bleachers. Any wrestler/spectator sitting or standing on the edge of the mat will be moved. Wrestlers may be disqualified if they are removed from the mat multiple times.
- Three mats will be used for the duration of the sectional event. Championship matches (1st, 3rd, 5th) will occur simultaneously for each weight class. The next weight class will not begin until all three bouts from the prior weight class have finished.
- Award presentations will occur throughout the championship matches in the Main Lobby. Wrestlers should make their way to the award area at the conclusion of their match to be presented with their awards.
- Coaches, Athletic Directors and Officials should be familiar with the 2024-2025 Wrestling Format.
- There will be a table near the entrance to the gymnasium set up for the Head Trainer and on site EMT.

CONCESSION STAND & MERCHANDISE

- There will be a concession stand in the cafeteria for the duration of the event. Food items should remain in the cafeteria or the lobby and should not be brought into the gymnasium. There will be a table designated for each team and additional tables for spectators.
- Merchandise will not be available on site. However, shirts and other items can be purchased <u>online</u> and shipped directly to purchaser. QR Codes to apparel store will be available in the cafeteria, gym and lobby.
