GAME OFFICIALS Responsibilities (See Rule 49.1)

The contest official who disqualifies a student under the provision of this rule must immediately inform the coach of each team, official scorer (if any), and state the violation. The contest official(s) must complete the student disqualification form(s) before leaving the site of the contest. If the game official fails to file the written student contest disqualification form, the individual is nevertheless bound by the suspension.

ATHLETIC DIRECTOR Responsibilities (See Rule 49.2)

The athletic director in charge of the contest, or designee, is responsible for 1) Having the official MIAA student contest disqualification form available for game officials on site. 2) Collecting the completed disqualification form(s) before leaving the site of the contest. 3) Sending copies of the completed disqualification form(s) to the principal and athletic director of each school involved and the Executive Director of the MIAA.
