## Skin Condition Policy

- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition must present an official [MIAA Physician's Release Form](#).

## Coaches Admission

- A maximum of **three (3) coaches per team** will be admitted free of charge.
  - Coaches must:
    - Check in with their team.
    - Bring and wear their Sectional-issued-name badge for mat access.

## ENTRANCES

- **Spectators:** Main Entrance – Bruce Landon Way
  - **Competing Athletes & Coaches:** Side Entrance – Dwight Street

## PARKING

- **CC CarPark** (Paid Parking)
    - Weekend event rate typically \$10
    - Standard weekday rate: \$2 per hour
    - Vans may park on the first level
  - **MGM Garage** (Free Parking)

# OUTSIDE FOOD & BEVERAGE POLICY

All food and beverage must be supplied by and purchased through the MassMutual Center.

**No outside food or beverage may be brought into the facility.**

## **Athletes / Competitors May Bring:**

- A small cooler with food and one bottle of water (or one personal reusable water bottle) to stay properly nourished and hydrated throughout the long day of competition.
  - The small cooler must be brought with the athlete at check-in and kept in the locker room. It may not be brought into the stands or mat area.

## **Parents / Spectators:**

- Single-use, under-consumption beverages (e.g., coffee) permitted
  - No outside food permitted
