- **GIRLS TOURNAMENT NOTE: UPDATE: D2 Girls Divisional States will take place on Saturday Only (2/21).** ~~Unless the number of participants changes significantly from last year, the D2 Girls Divisional State Tournament is expected to have select weight classes compete on both days, with wrestling through the second round of consolation matches on Friday.~~ This will be finalized during the week of the tournament once the girls' registration deadline passes (2/15). The Mixed Gender Tournament will also take place over both days.
- Please have **buses drop off** Athletes and Coaches at the Bus Loop in front of the school and have the buses park in the lower lot by the baseball field and tennis courts. **Buses may NOT part up at the school in either lot.**
- **As per MIAA, a maximum of three coaches per team will be allowed in for free and must check in with the team.**
  - These coaches will receive name badges at Sectionals, which they must bring and wear from Sectionals through Divisional States and All-States.

## WEIGHT IN AND SKIN CHECK:

- Weigh ins will be done in the performing arts center across from the gym.
- All referee and the on-site trainers will conduct the skin check prior to weigh in
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition **MUST** have an official [MIAA Physician's Release Form](#) signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

## PARKING

- Buses can drop the kids in the bus loop and then park either off campus until pickup time or in the lower lots by the baseball fields.
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lots on the school grounds. **Please only park in marked parking spaces. Parking on the grass or other areas are subject to police ticketing and towing - this is strictly enforced.**

## LOCKER ROOMS/RESTROOMS

- Male Wrestlers will use the locker room in the gym. Female wrestlers will use the locker room. They are located in the athletic hallway across from the gym.
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use clearly marked across from the gym.

- Only Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted and those in possession of them must sign in at the ticketing table.

## MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament. Athletes who need to be taped should be bring their own supplies.
- An AED will be the Athletic Training staff in the gymnasium and there is one mounted on the wall by the nurse's office.

## SEATING

- Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the gym or observe from the walking track. Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the mats at any time. There is no standing in front of the mats. Any spectator, regardless of age who goes anywhere else in the school, will be ejected without refund. This includes student athletes.

## FORMAT

- We will be using 6 mats throughout the course of the tournament.
- Championship Matches: There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks. There will be 3 mats for the finals

**CONCESSION STAND** - There will be 1 concession stand located outside of the gym
