SECTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: 1st - 3rd – 5th place matches will be held simultaneously. The next weight class will not start until all 3 bouts are finished.	*To start approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the previous round.	
Sectional Championship matches will have assistant referees.	*Wrestling is subject to start earlier.	

- Please have buses drop off in front of the main gym.
- The Lower door will be team entrance and handicapped accessible entrance only
- As per MIAA a **maximum of three coaches** per team will be allowed in for free and must check in with the team.
- Spectators will be allowed to enter at 8:00am.

#### WEIGH IN & SKIN CHECK. +2 (106 = 108)

- Weigh-ins will be done in the bottom gym by weight class.
- The head referee and the on-site trainer will conduct the skin check prior to the weigh in.
- Any wrestler with a visible skin condition **MUST** have an official [MIAA Physician's release form](#) signed and dated stating that the condition is non-communicable.

#### PARKING PUBLIC AND BUSES

- Buses may leave the facility and come back at the conclusion of the event OR they may park in the far parking lot behind the football stadium.
- Spectator parking will be available in the parking lots in front of the school. Please park in designated parking spots only.
- All athletes, coaches, and officials will enter through the lower gym doors.

- The General Public will go up the stairs outside the gym, handicapped accessible doors will be the lower gym doors..

### LOCKER ROOMS

- Wrestlers will use the two locker rooms under the gym. They will be clearly marked when teams arrive.
- Changing Rooms and bathrooms for female wrestlers will be available.
- Please note locker rooms are for athletes, coaches and officials. Spectators are not allowed.
- There will be public restrooms for spectator use.

### TICKETING THROUGH GOFAN

- General Admission: \$11.50 per day set by the MIAA
- Tickets can be purchased online here: <https://gofan.co/event/5924180?schoolId=MIAA> OR through a QR at the venue
- Only Official MIAA tournament passes are accepted and those in possession of them must sign in at the ticketing table.

### MEDICAL COVERAGE

- Athletic Trainers will be on site from skin checks until the end of the tournament.
- An AED will be the Athletic Training staff in the Field House.
- An EMT will be on site as well.

### SEATING

- Spectators will be able to enter and sit in the stands within the gym. Spectators are NOT ALLOWED on the main tourney floor inside the fenced off area. Please sit and be respectful of those around you.

### FORMAT

- We will be using **3 mats** throughout the course of the tournament.
- **Championship Matches:** There is no "set time" for championship matches. We are going to wrestle all the way through with minimal breaks.

### CONCESSION STAND

- There will be 1 concession stand that will be open throughout the tournament. It will be located in the school cafeteria under the gym. **All Food Should be consumed in the set up tables. NO COOLERS IN THE GYM**
