3. Finance Committee Report (Charlie Conefrey, Vice President)
 - a. Charlie reminded members the finance committee meets on a quarterly basis
 - b. Snapshot through December 2025.
 - i. Expenses are up. Currently net is \$566,000 however not all expenses are paid to date)
 - ii. Finance Committee members voted all GoFan revenue share be placed in into the Endowment fund, which will go back to our students
 - iii. \$100K allocated for tech and investment
 - iv. Approved Game Officials Fees for 2026-27 postseason

 - c. Bob informed board members of the downward trend in Tournament net. Increased expenses, venue, custodial police.
