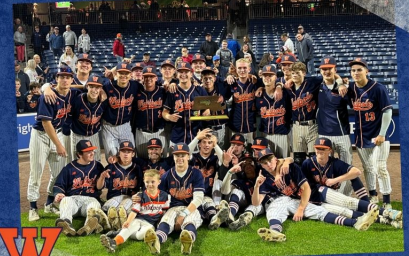

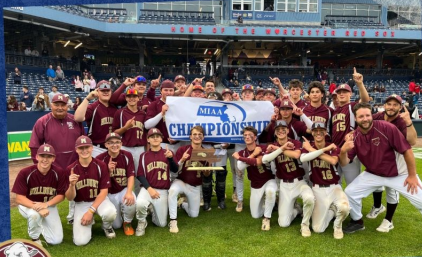

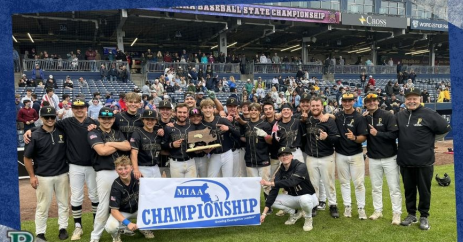

June 20, 1942 Turners Falls 5 – Arlington 4:

Harvey Welcome tripled home Art Burke with two outs in the ninth.

June 18, 1955 Newton 5 – Chicopee 4:

Dan Fogarty doubled home John McRoe with twos out in the ninth.

June 22, 1957 Durfee 4 – Springfield Tech 3:

John Driscoll's infield chopper to pitcher with one out in the ninth scored Doug Baxendale from third who slid in safely. Durfee trailed 3-0 going into the inning.

June 23, 1959 Belmont 2 – Pittsfield 1:

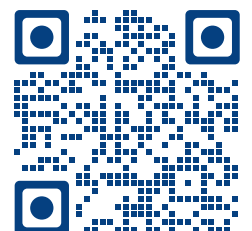

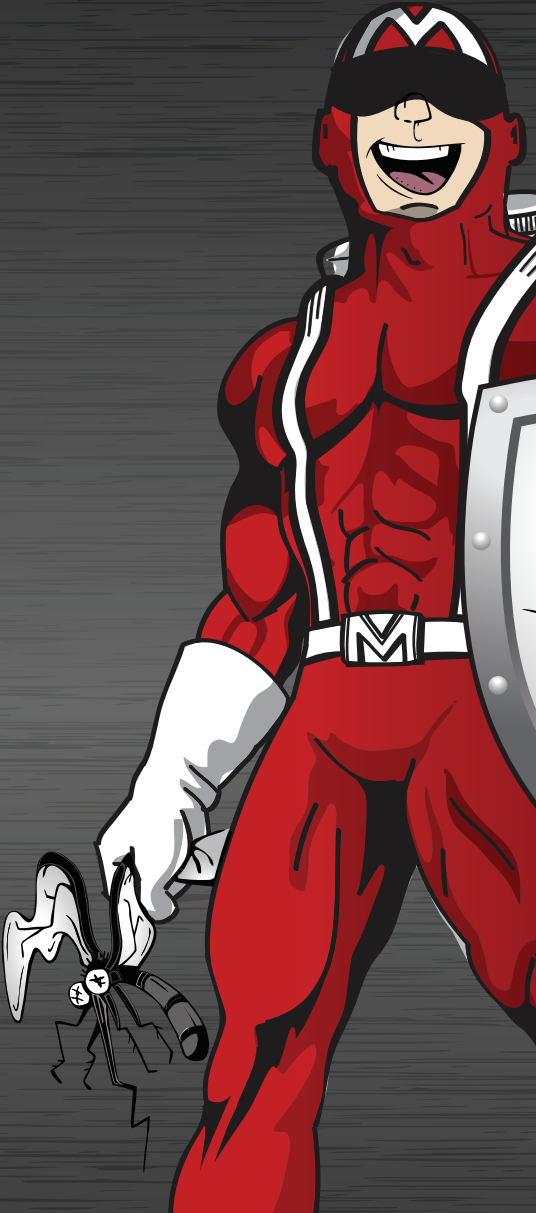

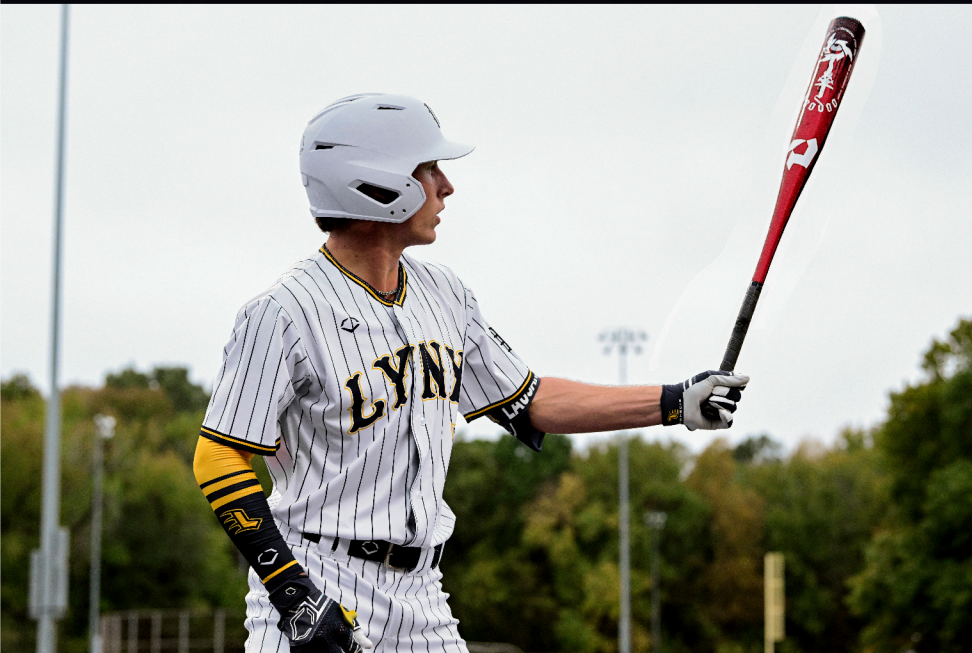
